To associate with Academic/Social/Cultural institutions/associations in organizing Training workshops in Curriculum, Faculty and Student Development.



Belagavi

Belagavi is a historical city nestled atop the Deccan Plateau at one edge of the Western Ghats, and is known for lush greenery, verdant river valleys, majestic mountain ranges, exotic natural beauty and the rich fauna. Thus blessed, Belagavi presents the best of natural and cultural beauty. The home of Nationalist icons such as Kittur Rani Channamma, Belavadi Mallamma, Krantiveer Sangolli Rayanna and others, it presently houses the head quarters of the Indian Army's most decorated Maratha Light Infantry Regiment (tracing its roots to Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj), an Air Force Base at Sambra, and the world renowned Commando Training Centre and the training centre CRPF's COBRA & ITBP. Thanks to its strategic location, Belagavi's role in the liberation of Goa in 1961 is well documented.

Belagavi reflects the confluence of Kannada, Marathi & Konkani Culture as seen in variety of languagues, food, fashion and festivities.

The Ram Krishna Mission Ashram at Fort stands testimony to Swami Vivekananda's retreat on his way to Chicago. Belagavi hosted the only session of Indian National Congress to be presided over by Mahatma Gandhi in 1924, where the water tank constructed for delegates, and since named Congress Well, continues to bear the witness of the historical moment. A thousand year old Kamal Basti (Jain Temple) in an architectural marvel situated in the Fort built by Rani Jakkala Devi and located in the heart of Belagavi.

Geographically located on the Golden Quadrilateral Belagavi, in addition to its agricultural prowess, is credited for a nationally ranked hydraulic manufacturing base, as well as the Foundry Industry. The airport at Sambra, the oldest in North Karnataka, has been in operation since 1942.

Belagavi is an education hub with three universities, VTU, RCU, and KLE Academy of Higher Education, who are all partners for STEP 2018.

An Emerging SMART City, Belagavi was designated as the second political capital of Karnataka with an annual winter session of the Assembly in the magnificent Suvarna Vidhan Soudha. The latest feather in the cap of this beautiful city is the installation of the largest national flag on the tallest mast on the banks of Kotekere lake standing at a height of more than 100 mtrs as a beacon of our national pride.
